Guidelines for Philosophy Undergraduate Student Directed Seminars:

1. This form must be submitted *prior to* the beginning of the term in which the course will be offered;
2. The student must select a topic/area of interest and the supervising faculty member they wish to work with;
3. In consultation with the supervising faculty member, the student must design a mutually agreed upon course outline. This should include a list of reading materials and assignments/papers to be written;
4. Course work must be completed and a final grade submitted before the end of the exam period for the term;
5. Credit/D/Fail grading is not available for directed studies (DST) courses. A final grade must be submitted for the student;
6. No more than 6 credits of DST courses (i.e. Directed Reading and Student Directed Seminars) may be counted toward an undergraduate degree in Philosophy;
7. Please allow 24 hours for the course to be created.
